No. 2/ELEC(KPI)/SSR-2018/19: In pursuance of Election Commission of India's letter No. 23/1/2019-ERS dated 19th February, 2019 and Chief Electoral Officer, Manipur letter No.29/05/2018/ELEC/SVEEP/LS 2019 dated 19th February, 2019, regarding Special Camps to be organized at every polling stations on 23rd & 24th February, 2019 to eligible voters. Booth Level Officers (BLOs) of 46-Saikul (ST), 50-Kangpokpi (Gen) & 51-Saitu (ST) ACs shall remain present in the Camps along with the copies of Final Electoral Rolls, 2019. The electoral rolls shall also be read out publically during the camp to facilitate illiterate voters.

All the EROs are directed to personally monitor and ensure presence of BLOs in their respective Polling Station and complete the due process of law and dispose of the forms received during the camps within 7th March, 2019. The data entry of forms received during the campaigns in the format available on CEO's Website latest by 25th February, 2019 and information about disposal forms shall be given through Website by 7th March, 2019.

3. It is also hereby informed to all the recognized political parties functioning within Kangpokpi District to depute the parties nominated Booth Level Agents (BLAs) to present at their respective polling station on the days of Special Camps.
